My School DC Lottery

My School DC, in partnership with DCPS and the majority of DC public charter schools, makes it easier for students and families to apply to their public school options. Families use the My School DC application to apply to PK3 and PK4 programs at any public school (DCPS or charter), to out-of-boundary and citywide DCPS schools (PK3-Grade 12), to DCPS selective high schools and programs (Grades 9-12), and to participating public charter schools (PK3-Grade 12). Placement for new students at participating schools is determined by a single, random lottery. My School DC is a program of the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE).

KEY WORDS



Citywide School: A school that does not have a designated boundary and therefore cannot be claimed as an in-boundary school. Citywide schools can only be accessed through the lottery and do not provide guaranteed enrollment to any student/family. Students from across the District of Columbia must submit a My School DC lottery application to attend a citywide school. Students are not eligible to receive proximity preference at citywide schools. Capitol Hill Montessori, Excel Academy, and Leckie Education Campus (grades 6-8 only) are the only citywide schools with middle grades.



Destination School (also Feeder Pattern School): A school that a student has the right to attend based on completion of the terminal grade of a student's current school. This assignment only happens during the years a student moves from elementary to middle school, or from middle school to high school, or from an education campus to high school.



In-Boundary School (also Neighborhood or Zoned School): A school that a student has the right to attend based on a student's home address. To identify your student's in-boundary school, visit **enrolldcps.dc.gov/node/41**.



My School DC Application: An online application that families must use to apply for all DCPS preschool (PK3) and prekindergarten (PK4) programs, including at their DCPS in-boundary school; DCPS out-of-boundary schools (PK3-12); DCPS dual language strand programs at any DCPS school (PK3-5); DCPS citywide schools (PK3-12); and DCPS selective high schools and programs (9-12).



My School DC Lottery: A single, random lottery that determines placement for new students at all participating My School DC lottery schools.



NAF College & Career Academy: A DCPS career education program that includes a strong student and teacher support structure, college and industry partnerships, career-focused internships, and rigorous curricula that culminates in industry-recognized certifications.



Out-of-Boundary School: A school other than a student's in-boundary school.





Lincoln Multicultural Middle School @ CHEC is a unique, globally-themed, 6-8 dual language campus that blends rigorous instruction with personalized education, driven by technology, bilingualism and social justice. All students in middle school have their own tablets and/or laptops. On a daily basis, Lincoln MS students get to apply technology, research, and real-life experiences in their curriculum, which enables them to prepare for high school and college.

Lincoln MS also has Spanish Language Arts and English teacher collaborating time to further enhance the student's experience in being a language learner. Regardless of a student's English or Spanish language proficiency levels, their ELA and SLA class collaboration model will ensure students are bilingual by the end of their 8th grade year.
